CURRICULUM



COURSES OFFERED

- WIND BAND (1, 2, 3, and 4)
- MARCHING BAND (OPE and JV)
- JAZZ BAND (1 and 2)
- STEEL BAND
- PERCUSSION ENSEMBLE
- COLOR GUARD



CONCERT BAND

- Enter "Wind Band 4" as your #1 elective on your Choice Sheet
 - Rank your other electives 2, 3, and 4
 - If you make Wind Bands 1 or 2, counselors will drop your 4th choice; those two classes are double blocked
- Bowie Band Directors will visit middle schools for auditions and place incoming students into the appropriate concert band.
 - Early March: Pass out music
 - Early April: Audition students
- **CONCERT BAND 1 & 2** will be double blocked and meet daily
- **CONCERT BAND 3 & 4** will be single blocked and meet on "B" Days

**All Concert Bands require JBHS Director Approval

**All <u>Percussion</u> students will single block band and have a percussion ensemble class



MARCHING BAND

- All students in a CONCERT BAND must be enrolled in MARCHING BAND
 - Enter "Marching Band" in the Before/After school spot
 - PE credit after 2 years
- James Bowie High School Outdoor Performing Ensemble (**JBHSOPE**)
 - Spring Camp April 29th May 3rd
 - Movement Camp May 27th 28th
 - Summer Band starts on July 22nd, and concludes at the start of the school year
 - School year rehearsals occur on weekdays, outside of the school day
 - Football games and Saturday performances throughout the fall
 - Audition for primary and secondary marching band positions
- JV Marching Band
 - Only for students with unsolvable schedule conflicts with OPE
 - Very different band experience at this level
 - Spring Camp, Movement Camp, and one week of Summer Band Camp
 - Participation at home games only; rehearsal on those days before school
 - Discuss with a band director to choose this option

Spring Camp: April 29th - May 3rd

May 27th - 28th Movement Camp:

Color Guard Camp: June 17th-20th

Summer Band Camp: Starts July 22nd Three weeks of all-day camp

One week of only-evening camp







FALL REHEARSAL SCHEDULE (NEW!)

Weekdays, once school starts

<u>August-September</u>

Monday-Friday 7-8:45am Game day rehearsal will end at 8am followed by a rehearsal with Silver Stars and a run through of our halftime performance

October (when temperature allows)

Monday 7-8:30am Monday 5:15-7:45pm Tuesday OFF Wednesday-Friday 7-8:30am Game day rehearsal will end at 8am followed by a rehearsal with Silver Stars and a run through of our halftime performance

Why the change?

Student safety

AISD's new heat guidelines require 5 minute breaks every 20 minutes anytime the temperature is over 95 degrees. That means 30 total minutes of lost time and a very fragmented rehearsal. Based on last year, there was only 1 rehearsal until October with a high of less than 95 degrees. Rehearsing in the morning allows us to keep students safer in cooler temperatures and be more productive with our time.

Respecting student time

We hope that giving students back all of their evenings in the beginning of the semester, and only having one evening rehearsal in October, allows for more flexibility with student work schedules, and more time for students to get homework done and to study.

PERCUSSION

Battery (drumline) and Front Ensemble (pit)

- Every percussion student enrolled in band must be enrolled in a percussion class.
 - Students will **single block** Concert Band and also have a Percussion class
 - Enter "Percussion" as your #2 elective on your choice sheet
- 2 classes Percussion Battery and Percussion Pit
 - Students will be placed in classes after spring rehearsals and auditions
 - Fall focus on marching/region music, Spring focus on percussion ensembles
- Open rehearsals will start in March and continue through the spring. These will be outdoor rehearsals, weather permitting.

JAZZ BAND

Jazz Band 1 & Jazz Band 2

- Jazz 1 by audition only
 Auditions early April
- Jazz 2 no audition or experience required
- Requires JBHS Director Approval
- CONCERT BAND enrollment required
 - Exception for guitar, bass, and piano players
- Performance opportunities around Austin and other cities

STEEL BAND



- No experience needed! All are welcome to join!
 Ability to read music is a plus, but not required.
 - Student does not have to be enrolled in concert band to join.
- Performance opportunities around campus and the Austin area.

COLOR GUARD

- Dedicated class
- No prerequisite; anyone is welcome to join!
- Dance and movement experience is a plus.
- Color Guard Summer Camp: June 17th-20th
- Must be enrolled in the COLOR GUARD class (6th Period) as well as the MARCHING BAND (before/after school course) for the fall
- Can be one semester, or year-long (referred to as Winter Guard in the spring semester)

Item	Fee (all approx.)	Description
Marching Band - OPE Fair Share Fee	\$750 [\$150 of that is paid at Spring Camp as registration for the coming year]	REQUIRED. Funds year-round band/guard program's annual operating expenses not provided by Austin ISD. Examples: marching drill design, music arrangement/copyrights, certain contest fees, school & charter buses, props, and specialized marching and guard instruction.
Color Guard Fair Share Fee	\$600 [\$150 at registration]	REQUIRED (See above)
Marching Band Summer Uniform & Gear	\$230	REQUIRED. Worn during warm weather football games, and used at events when not in competition uniform. Includes polo, shorts, marching shoes, dry-fit, pep shirt, hoodie, rain gear, jug koozie, and duffle bag.
Color Guard Summer Uniform & Gear	\$440	REQUIRED. Worn during warm weather football games, and used at events when not in competition uniform. Includes gloves, flag bag, top, leggings, warm-up pants, dance sneakers, guard shoes, pep shirt, hoodie, rain gear, jug koozie, backpack, and rifle.
Competition Meals	\$120	REQUIRED. Meals and snacks provided by the Hospitality team during marching competitions.
Instrument & Equipment Usage Fee	\$50	Annual fee charged to students who use district-owned instruments and equipment (oboe, French horn, baritone, tuba, percussion, guard, etc.)
Feed the Dawgs	\$90	OPTIONAL, but recommended. Meals delivered to the band hall after school on football game days.
Photos	\$40-\$120	OPTIONAL. Every student must take a photo in uniform, but you choose whether or not to buy a photo package.
